Overview

The development will include:

- Affordable Housing 30% of the homes have been provided as Affordable Housing with 70% of those units made available as rental accommodation and 30% Shared Ownership and provided to Arun District Council.
- Provision of Public Open Space to the south of Summer Lane with equipped children's play area.

Public Open Space

Discussions with the Council are ongoing with a full schedule and programme of works to be agreed. This is hoped to be achieved by May 2024.

Once this has been agreed the remedial works will approximately take 8 weeks from commencement with planting to take place at the start of the planting season in Autumn 2024

These works will include the removal of existing landscaping, play area and fencing. We will then be replacing the topsoil, installing new fencing, pathways, new landscaping/seeding and a refit play park with fencing. Further updates with opening dates will be issued once the works have commenced.



Key works and Site activity

• EV car chargers – Work is still ongoing on the final few charging points that are to be installed on individual homes, awaiting technical to advise on how to carry out the installation with the plots allocated a post. 19 still to be completed.

How will the development benefit the local community?

Drew Smith Homes will also support the local community by contributing over £831,000 towards:

- Education A total contribution of over £672K to be used towards primary, secondary and Sixth Form education for The Regis School including additional equipment
- Fire and Rescue Services A contribution to be used towards fire and rescue services as well as the provision and installation of community fire link smoke detectors for vulnerable persons homes in the parish of Pagham.
- Willowhale Library Over £30K to be used towards the development and a community meeting space and improvements to the Library to encourage an increase in community use.
- Green Open Spaces A contribution of over £129k towards the management and maintenance of the public open space to the south of Summer Lane, the Pagham Area of National Open Green Spaces and the provision of land and a contribution of £15k towards the provision of a public footpath to Spinnaker View.
